# Drinking Water: Water Use and Regulations





# Municipality of Campbell's Bay By-law 103-14 - Regulations for the use of drinking



On September 2, 2014, council adopted a bylaw on the use of drinking water. This by -law came into force on September 8, 2014

#### Quebec drinking water Savings Action Plan

Following article 49 of the National Water Policy and under the responsibility of the Ministry of municipal Affairs and Land Occupancy, a report regarding the measures to implement as part of a Quebec drinking water Savings Action Plan was created in 2005.

The province of Quebec has 3% of renewable freshwater on the planet and it covers about 10% of the territory. Quebec is one of the largest consumers of water worldwide. In fact, in 2006, the drinking water production in Québec was 35% higher than the Canadian average and 62% higher than Ontario.

The Action Plan has two objectives to meet by 2017:

- To reduce the average production of water per person by 20%
- To reduce the leakage rate for all water distribution systems by 20%

BY-LAW 103-14 AT A GLANCE...

### Watering lawns

- Watering lawns and gardens manually (a hose held by a person) is permitted every day and at anytime.
- Watering lawns by automatic watering systems is permitted from 3am to 6am, Tuesdays and Thursdays only.
- Watering lawns mechanically (portable sprinklers or porous hoses) is permitted between 8pm and 11pm only. The following schedule applies for mechanical watering on properties:

**Even street numbers:** 

On days when the date is an even number Odd street numbers:

On days when the date is an uneven number

### **Pools and Spas**

 Filling a pool or spa is permitted from 8pm to 11pm

## Vehicles, driveways, patios or exterior walls of a building

- Washing vehicles is permitted at all times on condition that a bucket or a hose fitted with an automatic shut-off device is used.
- The washing of driveways, patios and buildings is permitted from April 1 to May 15 each year only.
- It is strictly prohibited, at all times, to use drinking water to melt snow or ice on driveways, grounds or patios.

#### Water Features

 Any water feature must be equipped with an activated release system. A continuous stream of drinking water to feed the feature is prohibited.

#### Surface drainage

It is prohibited for anyone to deliberately use a watering device in such a way that the water runs into the street or onto neighboring properties.

A complete copy of the by-law is available to view at the municipal office from Tuesday to Friday from 8:30 am to 12pm and 1pm to 4pm.

# A FEW TIPS FOR KEEP-ING YOUR LAWN HEALTHY

In July, lawns are dormant and require much less water. Your lawn only needs to be watered once a week.

Keeping your lawn 6 or 7 cm long will enable it to better retain water, which will keep the ground moist, especially during a drought.

Place plants requiring full sun in the sun and plants requiring shade in a shaded area.
