

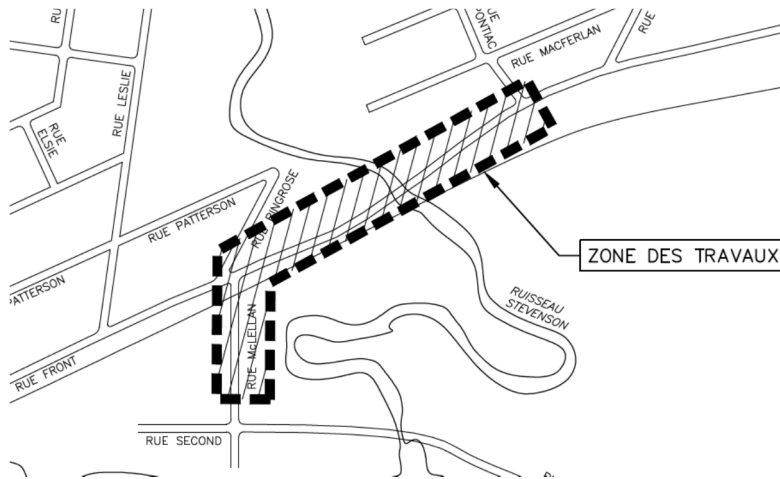

To the residents and businesses of the Municipality of Campbell's Bay:

❖ CONSTRUCTION WORK – REPLACEMENT OF THE MAIN WATER LINE – FRONT AND MCLELLAN STREETS



The municipality of Campbell's Bay wishes to advise residents and businesses that work to replace the main water line for parts of Front and McLellan Streets will begin on October 17, 2016. As part of the Gas Tax Transfer program, the project aims to maintain a high standard of quality water throughout the municipal distribution network. According to the proposed schedule, the construction period will be 3 weeks.

During this period, a temporary water supply system will be in place for the affected area. There will be brief

interruptions of water, boil water notices and traffic restrictions in this area. Access for pedestrians and access to buildings will be maintained throughout the construction period. We invite you to stay informed concerning these developments via public notices posted at the bulletin board situated at the Municipal Office and through the Campbell's Bay Facebook Page and website: www.campbellsbay.ca. All efforts to minimize noise caused by construction equipment are in place. Despite all precautions, we apologize for any inconvenience this may cause you and we thank you for your co-operation.

❖ MAINTENANCE AND FLUSHING OF FIRE HYDRANTS

The municipality will proceed with its semi-annual maintenance and flushing of fire hydrants. Consequently, there can be a slight drop in pressure and discolouration of the water. It is sufficient to let the water run for a few minutes, preferably the cold water tap in the bathtub, since it is not equipped with filters.

❖ FALL AND WINTER SCHEDULE - TRANSFER SITE

As of October 1, 2016, the transfer site will be open on Saturdays only, from 8:00 am to 4:00 pm.

❖ PAVEMENT REPAIR OF MUNICIPAL STREETS

During the month of October, the municipality will proceed with the paving repair of certain sections of municipal streets. Please respect the work site safety and traffic signage during this time.
