

July 11, 2018 - REMINDER FOR RESIDENTS SERVED BY THE MUNICIPALITY OF CAMPBELL'S BAY POTABLE WATER SYSTEM:

Due to the persistent heat wave, the Municipality invites the citizens to be vigilant regarding potable water consumption. Several easy steps can be taken to conserve this precious resource, here are a few:



RESPECT THE MUNICIPAL BYLAW 103-14 - REGARDING REGULATIONS FOR THE USE OF DRINKING WATER

If necessary, water the lawn moderately in the evening between <u>8 pm and 11 pm</u>; on even days if the home address is an even number and on odd days if the address is an odd number, by means of oscillating water sprinklers or perforated hoses.

For automatic watering systems, watering is permitted from $\bf 3$ am to $\bf 6$ am on Tuesdays and Thursdays only.

- Keep the lawn at a height of 8-10 cm.
- Leave grass clippings on the lawn when mowing your lawn. This contains a lot of water and will act
 as fertilizer.
- Add mulch to your landscaping: Reduce your watering needs by 75%!
- Install a solar blanket on your pool to avoid evaporation and fill the pool up to 15 cm from the edge.
- Collect rainwater through a barrel and use it for the vegetable garden and flowers.
