- No comments inciting racial, religious, ethnic or other hatred;
- No foul language;
- No promotion or act to discredit a political party or its representatives;
- The comments must be relevant and relate to the content of the published topics;
- No repeated comments, spam and advertising in any form.
- The Municipality of Campbell's Bay is not responsible for the comments and opinions of users.

The Municipality of Campbell's Bay allows users to add hyperlinks as long as the content is related to the topics covered. It is understood that the Municipality of Campbell's Bay is not responsible for the content of these external sites.

The Municipality of Campbell's Bay reserves the right to remove any comments that it deems inappropriate or that do not comply with this policy or the terms of use of social media. The Municipality of Campbell's Bay may also ban a subscriber if they find that the subscriber does not follow the established rules.

Normally, the Municipality of Campbell's Bay makes sure to follow up on the exchanges made on its Facebook page. A constant watch of social media is thus carried out. Although the use of social media implies the notion of speed and immediacy, checks must be made with the various services. A delay is expected when required.
