



PUBLIC NOTICE

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PERSONS ENTITLED TO VOTE TO BE INCLUDED ON THE REFERENDUM LIST OF THE WHOLE MUNICIPALITY

- 1) At a council meeting on May 07, 2019, the Council of the Municipality of Campbell's Bay adopted the By-Law 102-19 entitled: Bylaw declaring an expenditure of \$176,000 and a loan of \$176,000 and an appropriation of \$176,000 from the general fund for the purchase and installing a SplashPad in the recreation and sport park.
- 2) Persons entitled to vote who are entitled to be included on the municipal referendum list may request that By-law 102-19 be the subject of a referendum by entering their names, address and quality and by signing a register opened for that purpose.

Individuals who are entitled to vote who want to register their name must present an identification card, such as a health insurance card, a driver's licence, a passport, a certificate of Indian status or a Canadian Forces identity card.

- 3) The registry will be available from 9 a.m. to 7 p.m. on May 21st, 2019, at the municipal office of Campbell's Bay, 59 Leslie Street.
- 4) The number of signatures required for a referendum on By-law 102-19 is fifty-three (53). If this number is not reached, By-law 102-19 will be deemed approved by the persons entitled to vote.
- 5) The result of the registration process will be announced at 9:00 a.m. on May 22nd, 2019 at the municipal office located at 59, Front street in Campbell's Bay.
- 6) The By-law is available for consultation at the municipal office from Tuesday to Friday from 8:30 a.m. to 12 p.m. and from 1 p.m. to 4 p.m.

Conditions for being a person entitled to vote to be included on the referendum list for the whole municipality:

- 7) A person who, on May 07, 2019, is not unable to vote under section 524 of the Municipal Elections and Referendum Act and meets the following conditions:
 - a. be a natural person domiciled in the municipality and have been domiciled for at least 6 months in Quebec and;
 - b. be of age and Canadian citizenship and not be in curatorship.
- 8) Any sole proprietor of a building or sole occupant of a business establishment who is not unable to vote and meets the following conditions:
 - a. have owned or been a sole occupant of a business establishment located in the municipality for at least 12 months;
 - b. in the case of a natural person, being of age and Canadian citizenship and not being a curator.
- 9) Any undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-owner of an enterprise establishment who is not unable to vote and who meets the following conditions:
 - a. have been an undivided co-owner of an immovable or co-owner of a business establishment located in the municipality for at least 12 months;
 - b. be designated, by means of a power of attorney signed by the majority of persons who have been co-owners or occupants for at least 12 months, such as the person who is entitled to sign the register on their behalf and be entered on the referendum list, where applicable. This power of attorney must have been filed before or at the time of signing the register.
- 10) Legal entity
 - a. have by resolution designated, from among its members, directors or employees, a person who, on May 07, 2019 and at the time of exercising that right, is a person of majority status and is a Canadian citizen, who is not in curatorship and is not incapacitated by law to vote.
