



## PUBLIC NOTICE - **IMPORTANT INFORMATION, PLEASE READ!** CORONAVIRUS – COVID-19

Campbell's Bay, April 9, 2020

The Municipality continues to follow the recommendations of the Government of Quebec while ensuring that essential services are maintained and provided in accordance with the directives issued by the authorities.

### **TRANSFER SITE - CLOSED**

The transfer site is now closed to the public. In the meantime, you must keep at home all materials considered non-urgent for disposal such as:

Furniture  
Tires  
Metal  
Brush and leaves  
Paint and oil  
Electronics and household appliances

*The Municipality asks that every resident be respectful and show civility, please do not throw your waste other than at an authorized location. Such behavior constitutes a violation of article 10 of bylaw# S.Q. 2011-03 (96-12) concerning nuisances.*

### **WEEKLY COLLECTION OF DOMESTIC (HOUSEHOLD) WASTE**

The weekly curbside pick-up of domestic waste remains undisturbed since it is an essential service.

▲ **Please have your garage bags placed at the curbside for 8:00 am on Wednesdays. We also ask to cover your garbage bags with a sheet or place them in a bin with a secure cover.**

? **What is considered household waste?** Household garbage includes all residual material that is non-recyclable and non-hazardous, destined for elimination provided that they are in plastic bags.

### **BIWEEKLY COLLECTION OF RECYCLING**

The biweekly curbside pick-up for recycling remains undisturbed since it is an essential service. Make sure to continue sorting your recycling materials diligently!

### **FIRE BAN**

The municipality of Campbell's Bay issued a complete outdoor fire ban on April 4, 2020. This fire ban includes protective screened-in outdoor fireplaces. We remind you that fireworks are also prohibited at all times.

### **DO NOT FLUSH YOUR WIPES!**

The Municipality issued a notice on March 20, 2020, regarding the flushing of wipes, paper towels and similar products. These products will clog sewers and cause backups and overflows creating an additional public health risk in the midst of the Coronavirus pandemic. **PLEASE DISPOSE YOUR WIPES IN THE TRASH CAN!**

### **MUNICIPAL CLOSURES**

The Municipal office, parks and recreational spaces including the RA Hall remain closed until May 4, 2020, or until authorized by the Québec Government.
