

PROGRAM FOR INCREASED PROTECTION OF DRINKING WATER SOURCES

On June 27, 2018, la ministre du Développement durable, de l'Environnement et de la Lutte contre les changements climatiques unveiled the 2018-2030 Québec Water Strategy and its 2018-2023 action plan. This action plan includes the launch of the Programme pour une protection accrue des sources d'eau potable (PPASEP) - PROGRAM FOR INCREASED PROTECTION OF DRINKING WATER SOURCES.

The PPASEP supports the Regulation respecting Water Withdrawal and Protection (RPEP), enacted on July 16, 2014. This regulation notably obliges the municipalities responsible for a water distribution system supplying more than 500 people (category 1) to send the Minister a report presenting the results of the analysis of the vulnerability of their sources and drinking water withdrawal sites. The purpose of producing this report is to enable municipalities to identify the challenges of protecting their drinking water sources and the threats to them, in addition to promoting information sharing with stakeholders. .
